Buttonwood Farm Winery is a small family winery located in the heart of Santa Barbara County's Santa Ynez Valley. Our thirty-nine acre vineyard stretches across a sun drenched mesa on the eastern portion of our 106 acre property. Winemaker Michael Brown has been making wine at Buttonwood since we started in 1989. Our current production level is about 8,000 cases each year.

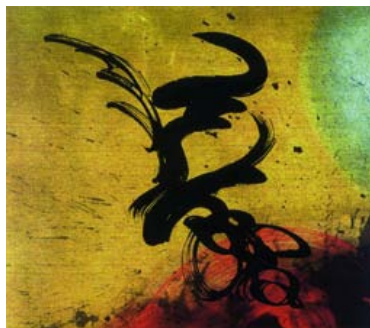
Red Table Wine Introducing Buttonwood Hawk Red.
